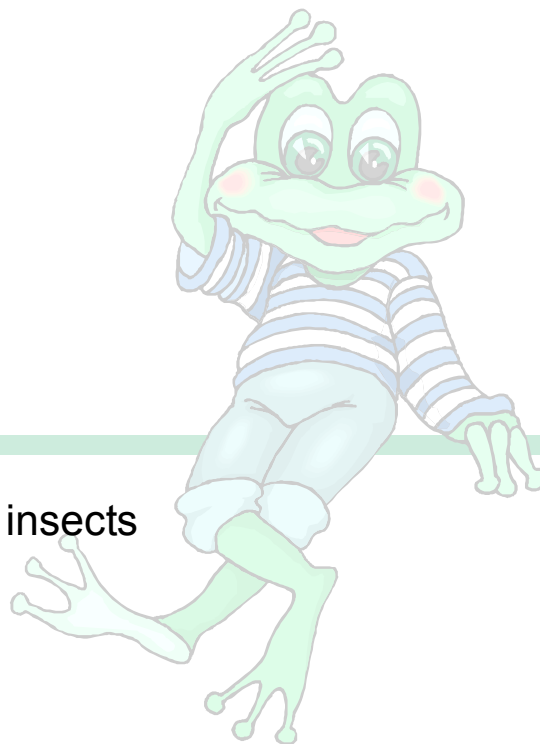
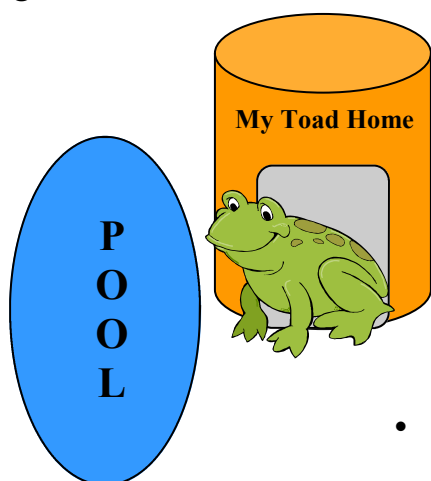


Build A Toad Home



Toads are a gardener's friend. They'll eat insects and caterpillars that may be harmful to plants. How can you get a toad in your garden? Make a toad house!



- Using a clean plastic container, cut a half-circle “doorway” out of the top edge of the container; it should be large enough for a toad to fit through. Make sure to ask an adult to help if you needed.
- Turn the container upside down, and decorate it as you wish.
- When you get home. Put the container upside down at the edge of your garden.
- Right next to the toad's house, dig a hole big enough for another container to fit in, right side up.
- Fill the hole with water. You just made a pool for your toad!
- Now wait and watch for the toad!
